

「2010 國際會議」將於明年6月10-14日假本港舉行。是次大型國際會議將吸引本地及海外超過2,000多位業內及相關人士參與，大會期望訂立一份行動綱領，指導未來10年的社會工作及社會發展。

香港作為會議的主辦地區，正積極籌備各項工作，其中將於本年七月至九月期間舉行一系列會議前培訓項目，希望促進業界以實證為本(Evidence-based Practice)，記載並推動發展更多高質素、優越及革新的社會工作、社會發展實踐及倡導工作。

“2010 Joint World Conference on Social Work and Social Development” will be held in Hong Kong from June 10-14 next year. Over 2,000 professionals and concerned parties will meet and exchange at the event aiming to develop an action agenda for social work and social development in the next decade.

To facilitate the local sector in documenting and developing quality, excellent and innovative social development and social work strategies by means of evidence-based practice, a series of Pre-conference Training Programmes is now scheduled from July to September 2009.
